### Population Estimates - years (1985 to 2010)

Population estimates are produced annually by the State Demography Office. The most recent estimate available is for the year of 2010 and was finalized in October 2011.

Population forecasts are produced annually by the State Demography Office. Our most recent forecasts were produced in October 2011.
